MESSAGE FROM THE EDITOR

TRADITIONALLY AS WE ENTER THE FINAL QUARTER EACH YEAR, WE BEGIN TO REFLECT ON THE GOLFING HIGHLIGHTS WE'VE ENJOYED OVER THE PRECEDING MONTHS.

A s well as recalling our own personal bests and favourite moments on the Classic and Masters courses, we fondly remember marvelling at the feats of the world's best golfers in The Masters from Augusta National in April, the US Open in June and the Open Championship in July.

However, 2020 has been no ordinary year. Anything but. In some shape or form, each and every one of us have had our lives disrupted by the Covid-19 pandemic and the protocols and guidelines laid down by our political leaders to try and counter the virus.

In Singapore that meant Laguna National, along with all other sports clubs in the country, was placed under lockdown for a 10-week period. The club resumed operations on June 19, since when both of our courses have been packed to the hilt.

In the United States and United Kingdom, surveys have revealed that a record number of rounds have been played over the past few months as golfers – old and new – flock to courses to take advantage of the game's many virtues, including being out in the open air and natural social distancing.

It's been a similar story in many parts of Asia, where there's evidence of a rise in golfing participation, driven by former team sports players turning to golf for their regular sporting fix.

At the same time, research has identified that uncertainty surrounding international travel and a fear of having to quarantine on return has driven, and will continue to drive, increased domestic golf tourism. With less than 50 per cent of golfers believing it will be safe to travel abroad for a golf break before April 2021, expect that trend to continue for a while yet.

While it's been good to see friends and families enjoying regular golfing outings at Laguna National, the cancellation of club tournaments, predominantly due to restrictions regarding size of gatherings which would prevent any award ceremonies, has been regrettable. While we staged a Ladies Meet Up in January and the ever-popular Hong Bao Competition on the first day of February, the only other club events we were able to hold were the Monthly Medals for January, February and March.

We'd normally now be gearing up for our club championships for men and women, always among the highlights on our annual calendar of events. The club had also been in discussions to stage a couple of professional events at our venue in the final quarter on 2020. Sadly these, too, have been put on hold.

It is the hope of all that tournament golf – amateur and professional – will return to the fairways of Laguna National at the first available opportunity, as will inter-club contests and overseas trips.

This year it had been the intention for a group of Members to attend the Masters Tournament. As we now know, The Masters was postponed and the trip was cancelled.

Good news for golf fans is that the 2020 Masters has been rescheduled and will go ahead from November 12-15, the first time in its storied history it's been played at this time of year. For the first time also, there will be no patrons on the hallowed site, to the regret of all, including Augusta National Chairman **Fred Ridley**.

"Even in the current circumstances, staging the Masters without patrons is deeply disappointing. The guests who come to Augusta each spring from around the world are a key component to making the tournament so special," said Ridley.

"Augusta National has the responsibility, however, to understand and accept the challenges associated with this virus and take the necessary precautions to conduct all aspects of the tournament in a safe manner. We look forward to the day when we can welcome all of our patrons back, hopefully in April 2021," he added.

Laguna National's Augusta-bound contingent will share those sentiments.

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ADAPTING TO 'NEW NORMALS'

IN HIS LATEST MESSAGE TO MEMBERS, LAGUNA NATIONAL GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB GENERAL MANAGER MARK ISLEY PROVIDES AN UPDATE ON A VARIETY OF FRONTS.

A nother few months have flown by and now we find ourselves entering the final quarter of 2020 – arguably the most tumultuous year in the lifetime of many of us.

The Covid-19 pandemic has caused unseen and unprecedented upheavals and prompted changes for us all, both on a personal level and professionally. Through necessity, we are having to become accustsomed to 'new normals' in all aspects of our existence.

At Laguna National Golf & Country Club, every conceivable step and measure has been taken to ensure the safety and well-being of our Members, guests and staff. That has always been our primary goal and where our attention has been most keenly focused. As you'll be aware, we've gone to extraordinary lengths to enable our golf courses to remain open, providing a welcome dose of normality to the lives of so many.

I'd like to take this opportunity, therefore, to publicly pay tribute to all of our golf course personnel and agronomy team who have performed their tasks so admirably during what have often been trying times, and while having to implement new standard operating procedures that adhere to strict Government guidelines.

It is testament to their skill, dedication and professionalism that both the Classic Course and Masters Course have been presented in such outstanding condition. Especially so when you consider the record-breaking number of rounds that have been taking place at Laguna National in the past four months.

Considering the circumstances, it's pleasing to receive so many words of praise from Members, who clearly have appreciated the efforts and attention to detail that have been put into maintaining our courses.

On behalf of the management, I'd also like to thank all of our Members – those of long-standing and the more recent arrivals – for their continued support, patience and understanding.

Which brings me on to the topic of our online booking programme. Demand for tee-times continues to be high and although there have been improvements to the system, we have still had experience with error messages and some inconsistencies on the booking calendar.

As we continue our efforts to introduce more efficient tee time booking procedures, we have been monitoring the booking results and the behaviour of Members' bookings within our current regulations. As a result, we are making adjustments to the booking procedures which will allow us to better manage fairer booking behaviour to allow more equal and efficient access to all tee times. These changes will help to reduce unnecessary traffic and superfluous bookings on the booking portal.

We have implemented a stricter cancellation policy designed to ensure Members are not blocking/booking times which they are not completely committed to using from the onset of booking, therefore making them more available and accessible to other Members from the onset of our booking start dates.

These changes came into effect for **ALL BOOKINGS FOR DATES OCTOBER 1 ONWARDS**, and will remain in effect until the club determines there are significant changes in demand for tee times as a result of changes to current Covid-19 restrictions.

Temporary Amendment to Booking Policy

- Bookings will open at 7 am, seven days in advance for all tee time bookings.
- Although encouraged, you are not required to input all of the names in your initial booking as searching Members names is sometimes slowed by the high traffic at peak times.
- You are required to have the names of **ALL** golfers updated in the system:
 - Weekday times* **48 hours** in advance
 - Weekend times* 72 hours in advance
- * Times that are not updated within this period **WILL BE RELEASED** and passed to Members on the waiting list. Full cancellation fees will apply.

Update names of your booking via My Bookings on the web portal or by email to the Club Concierge at **clubconcierge@lagunanational.com**

Temporary Amendment To Cancellation Policy

- ALL tee time cancellations will be subject to cancellation penalties **REGARDLESS OF ADVANCE TIMING**. The free cancellation periods **NO LONGER APPLY**. Members are encouraged to only book tee times they are fully committed to make full use of. Communicate with your fellow flight mates to ensure you do not make separate or multiple bookings for the same flight as **ALL** cancellations will be charged the appropriate fees.
- Reduction of players within a flight will also carry the appropriate cancellation fees.
- Although names of accompanying golfers may change, changing the name of the BOOKING Member is NOT PERMITTED. If the BOOKING Member's name needs to change, the entire flight will be cancelled and appropriate cancellation fees will be charged.

- Cancellation must be done via email to the Club Concierge at clubconcierge@lagunanational.com
- Cancellations fees:
 - Weekday* **\$30**/player
 - Weekend* **\$60**/player
- * Cancellation fees will be applied to the **BOOKING** Member. No show fees will be charged at **DOUBLE** the cancellation fee.



LAGUNA NATIONAL GOLF & COUNTRY Club has welcomed five new Hole-in-one achievers to its Roll of Honour.

Lam Man Choong (pictured above left) made the first ace of his life at the 17th hole on the Classic Course.

The 11th hole on the Classic Course was the scene of Yasuhito Imaizumi's second ace at Laguna National in 2020 (pictured above right). **U** olf, to coin a well-worn phrase, can be a funny old game. Just ask Laguna National members **Lam Man Choong** and **Yasuhito Imaizumi**.

After many years of trying, the duo finally added their names to the list of Laguna National members who have recorded an 'ace'.

Remarkably, in the instance of Imaizumi, he actually had the distinction of making two holes-in-one at his 'adopted' Singapore club within the first seven months of the golf-interrupted year.

Meanwhile, as so often seems to be case in this sport, Lam's magical moment came at a point where he was feeling growing frustration at the state of his game.

By his own admission, Lam had low expectations when he teed-off alongside his wife, **Yvette**, and the husband-and-wife pairing of **Loh Fook Meng** and **Siew Kheng**, on the Classic Course on August 25.

exception," said Lam, who will celebrate his 20th anniversary as a Member at Laguna National next August.

Heading out in the first flight of the day at 7 am, Lam raised his hopes of a return to form with an early birdie. But his optimism was short-lived. "It went downhill, thereafter," he admitted.

However, his mood would change for the better at the notoriously difficult 17th hole, which yielded just a single hole-in-one during 2019.

Opting to use his five-iron from the hybrid tee to a pin cut near the front of the green, Lam struck the shot well – but was unclear where it came to rest.

He said: "When I hit the shot, I was just glad I didn't see a splash in the water. With the sun in my eyes, I didn't see the ball go into the hole. It was Siew Kheng who suspected I holed it. But she thought maybe she shouldn't say it until she was sure when we approached the green.

"Having a hole-in-one saved the day for me. Not many golfers that I know have not had a hole-in-one ... and many others have done it multiple times. I'm just glad that I now have at least one! I hope to do this again at the right time – when a car is on offer!"

For Imaizumi, from a golfing perspective 2020 will be remembered as an *annus mirabilis* or 'miraculous year'.

In January, he achieved the first 'ace' of his life on the fifth hole of the Masters Course when playing in a two-ball with his wife. "Regretfully, I didn't report it to the golf club," said Imaizumi, who joined Laguna National in May, 2018.

There was no such reticence on his part on July 25 when he holed out with his six-iron from the blue tee at the 11th hole on the Classic Course.

"I hit the shot well, but did not see it on the green. But my flight mates watched the ball roll into the hole and got excited," said Imaizumi, whose playing partners were **Terence Tan**, **Fred Tay** and **Arnold Lim**.

"It made me realise that I was much calmer than when I witnessed other players make an ace. Maybe it was just too fantastic for me to accept," added Imaizumi, a single-figure handicapper.

Meanwhile, it was **Chia Joong Luang** who became the first golfer to record a hole-in-one at Laguna National following the reopening of the club's facilities on June 19.

On July 14, playing from the red tee, Chia holed out with her seven-iron tee-shot at the 107-yard fourth hole on the Classic Course.

In the case of **Ramagopal Rao** and **Mike Stephen**, Friday, September 18 proved to be a day to remember.

Using an eight-iron, Rao 'aced' the fifth hole on the Masters Course – the third time this year the feat has been achieved from the white tee there, measuring 155 yards.

For Stephen, his hole-in-one came just a week after taking up membership at Laguna National.

Quick to make himself feel at home in his new surrounds, Stephen holed out with his rescue club on the 11th hole of the Classic Course.

General Manager at Alliance Energy Solutions Group, Stephen was playing alongside two other new Members in **Craig Muir** and **Gerard Fitzgerald** and **Jonathan Miles**, a Member of 18 months standing.

By their own admission, Stephen and his flight mates were surprised to find his ball nestling in the hole on the elevated green.

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



'PULLING' YOUR CLUB IS A SURE-FIRE WAY TO PREVENT YOU FROM IMPROVING YOUR SCORING. IN HIS LATEST EXCLUSIVE INSTRUCTIONAL ARTICLE FOR LAGUNA LIFESTYLE, STEPHEN MORIARTY, DIRECTOR AT THE LEADBETTER GOLF ACADEMY, EXPLAINS.



here are numerous common denominators that link good golfers. One of the most obvious is that they all possess sharp short games. Not only are they proficient with their putters, but also the techniques they employ ensure they are consistently efficient with their chipping and pitching.

It's no secret that golfers with good short games, that work under pressure, allow the club to return to a position consistently where it reaches the ground without compensation and without the risk of hitting the shot heavy and seeing the club dig in to the turf.

For many amateurs, however, 'pulling' the club in their short game is a major issue. Fundamentally, the problem lies in the way the club responds to this force.

In trying to find a fix for this, it's helpful to have a little understanding of the way in which the short clubs in your golf bag work.

Wedges are specifically designed to help you in making good contact with the ground and to provide enough loft to hit the ball high with spin. 'Bounce' on the bottom of the club's sole stops it from digging into the ground.

However, the more you lean the club forward, as many amateurs do, the more negative the impact as it will reduce bounce, loft and spin – everything that is essential for good short game shots.

This brings me onto another point, which I believe to be the greatest sin in golf coaching.

Have you ever been told to put the ball back in your stance, lean your weight towards the target, push your hands forward and hit down on the ball? If so, then you were robbed of having any chance of being able to hit the shots you associated with great short game players.

For 99 per cent of the time, these players are doing the opposite. In regard to the other one per cent of the time that you may see them apply some of the above positions, they have the skill and coordination to still hit a good shot.

When you pull on the golf club, or try to keep your hands ahead of the clubhead, the club responds by going upwards. To put it another way, it stays high away from the ground.

Pictures 1a and 1b (*top*) show this reaction when I pull forwards.

The last thing we want when hitting short game shots is for the club to 'stay high' because that means we have to use another part of our body to bring the club down to the ball and ground.

For example, the club stays up when I pull on it, so I lean my body backwards to bring the club to the ground, as illustrated in **Picture 2** (*left*).

This is a very inconsistent and difficult way of achieving good impact. To create good impact, we want to allow the club to return to a similar position to how I've set up to hit the shot in **Picture 3** *(top)*. Here, there isn't too much shaft lean and I've given myself the greatest chance of being able to use both bounce and loft.

At Laguna National Golf & Country Club, we have one of the best short game practice facilities available in Singapore. It's a perfect place for you to work on the correct feeling and hone your short game shots.

In mid-October, we'll be launching new short game clinics to further help golfers in their quest for improved scores. Come and join us! I'd also strongly recommend that you take the time to visit one of the Titleist demo days at Laguna's driving range to see how adjusting your wedge selection can greatly improve the quality of your shots.

Here are key pointers you need to focus on

- Set up: Neutral set up position, small amount of shaft left, weight slightly left, soft elbows and light grip pressure. Grip at the top of the club, not down the shaft.
- Backswing: Small turn, maintain the softness in your wrists and elbows to allow the club to swing.
 Do not try to move the club back without any wrist hinge. Likewise, your wrists do not need to be excessively active.
- Transition: Here's the key, again with minimal pressure in wrists and elbows allow the club to start back down without pulling it. A simple feeling would be to maintain a constant swing radius, as illustrated in Picture 4 (*right*).
- **Downswing and impact:** With your hands and club working together, you need to add a small amount of rotation from your body to keep the club moving forwards through impact, as illustrated in **Picture 5** (*bottom left*).
- **Picture 6** (*bottom right*) illustrates what impact should look like.

ACADEMY TAKES AIM AT CONTINUED SUCCESS

NOW INTO ITS THIRD YEAR OF OPERATION, THE OUTSTANDING REPUTATION OF THE LEADBETTER GOLF ACADEMY (LGA) AT LAGUNA NATIONAL CONTINUES TO BE ENHANCED. HEADING INTO THE FINAL QUARTER OF 2020, THE ACADEMY IS AIMING FOR EVEN GREATER HEIGHTS WITH A SERIES OF SPECIAL CLINICS AND COACHING ACTIVITIES TO BE STAGED.

September marked the start of the third year of the Leadbetter Golf Academy at Laguna National. Not even the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic has dimmed the pleasure and pride felt by LGA Director **Stephen Moriart**y at the way in which his dedicated team of coaches is developing and the progress that has been made since the Academy's doors were opened for business in late 2018.

In June, **Nigel Bark** completed the Leadbetter Certification programme. In so doing, he had the distinction of joining an elite list of coaches globally who have become 'Leadbetter Certified'.

"Tremendous credit goes to Nigel for achieving this landmark," said Moriarty, adding that such has been the demand for Academy instruction that the LGA's team of coaches was expanded to five in late 2019 with the addition of **Joey Poh**.

A former national team player, Poh is currently working through the

"It is our hope that Joey will create a slice of history by becoming the first Singaporean Certified Leadbetter Coach," said Moriarty.

Among other things, Poh has been working closely with **David Bradshaw** to grow the junior programmes at the Academy. "I'm pleased to report that we recently commenced a new class, introducing golf to juniors as young as four and five years old. They will hopefully progress to the LGA Kids programme," added Moriarty.

While the launch of the LGA's eagerlyanticipated full-time programme has been temporarily placed on hold until international travel resumes, there are plenty of other areas in which there's ongoing activity.

As well as looking forward to staging new short-game clinics and a six-week programme for ladies, the Academy is relaunching its popular Aimpoint clinics.

For those who are not familiar with this simple green reading system, Aimpoint has been used by no fewer than five world number one players. In total, there have been 65 wins on major professional Tours by players using Aimpoint.

What began as a software programme used on the Golf Channel to accurately predict the break of putts has been developed into an easy-to-use system that allows a golfer to correctly and quickly identify slope, understand how speed will affect break and identify where you need to start your putt.

To set the ball rolling, the LGA will be putting on Aimpoint express Level 1 and Level 2 clinics. It's the intention to follow up with clinics for Level 3 and Level 4 towards the end of the year. All Aimpoint clinics run for two hours. To ensure every participant gets the most from each session, a limit has been set of five students for each clinic.

"If you're serious about improving your putting and lowering your score, then make sure to sign up as soon as possible," said Moriarty, who has guided more than 250 students through the Aimpoint system and will himself be conducting the clinics at the LGA.

"I've been working with students on Aimpoint for more than six years now and it's by far and away the best investment


"Once you have an understanding of how your ball will break on the green you will have a much clearer understanding of speed control and where the putt needs to be started. Even if you feel comfortable reading greens with your eyes, there's still a lot of useful information in the clinic that will help you with your putting and make improvements," added Moriarty.

To commemorate the second birthday of the Academy, a special promotion is running until the year end with the cost of the clinic reduced to \$\$200 per person.

ZEN GOLF: MINDFULNESS TRAINING

Focus your full attention on the shot at hand.

THE GOLF COURSE HAS BECOME A SAFE HAVEN FOR MANY PLAYERS AMID THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. LAGUNA NATIONAL IS THE PERFECT PLACE TO BE, NOT JUST BECAUSE THE TWO COURSES OFFER NATURAL SOCIAL DISTANCING, BUT BECAUSE A ROUND OF GOLF PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY TO ESCAPE FROM WORK, UNPLUG FROM OUR DEVICES, AND FEEL FREE. SPORTS PSYCHOLOGIST DR JAY-LEE NAIR EXPLAINS HOW YOU CAN ENHANCE FOCUS AND CLARITY ON THE GOLF COURSE.

Research has documented the adverse effects on our health of living in busy, dense, urban cities. No wonder psychologists are saying that during these exceptional times it's more important than ever for us to 'create space' in novel ways, because the weekend getaways or travel escapes that created the feeling of space and revival in the past have been so highly restricted for so many months.

Here are some very simple, but powerful, strategies from mindfulness training that can enhance focus and clarity on the golf course to create space and level headedness during these challenging times.

First, review your habits on the golf course during a typical game.

- Do you check your email or intermittently answer messages on your phone?
- Do you continue your conversation mid-way through your shot preparation or, even worse, when your playing partner is teeing-off?
- Do you often play 'there-abouts' golf, hitting the shot when you know it isn't the correct choice?

If these scenarios sound familiar, then you could be in a perpetual state of multi-tasking that is negatively impacting your focus, performance and enjoyment on the golf course.

In today's information rich society, we have greater opportunity, and temptation, to engage in two or more tasks at once. There is an illusion that this approach makes us more productive and powerful. In contrast, multi-tasking reduces efficiency and focus, contributing to poor decision-making, more mistakes, and higher levels of stress.

Performing multiple tasks in rapid succession requires an individual to reorient to each new task, which itself takes time and other attentional resources. We don't notice the effect on our performance with mindless tasks such as checking our phone while eating lunch, but when it comes to skills demanding intricate synchronisation of the mind and body a heightened sense of awareness is crucial for performance.

If we consider how the world's best golfers create peak performance, it is through an approach that combines fearsome focus in the present moment, a singular focus on one shot at a time, and total immersion in the task until the end result takes shape. Psychologists call this approach a mindful practice, or mindfulness, and it is essentially the opposite of multi-tasking.

In golf, mindfulness is like 'zoning in' one shot at a time. Instead of dwelling on your last bad shot or thinking ahead and predicting your score for the last three holes, you bring careful attention to what is happening in the moment. It is a state of raised consciousness that allows you to make non-reactive, purposeful decisions over the shot at hand.



For many years, Australian Jason Day has had a distinctiv pre-shot routine. The pre-shot routine isn't just about practice swings and club selection. The pre-shot routine is for letting go of tension in the body, enhancing commitment and clearing the mind right before you hit your shot.

For example, rather than ripping your driver off the tee because you three-putted the last green, you will be ready to commit to a smooth, calm swing and focus on your target instead of your score.

Here are **four ways** to bring mindfulness training into your next game for greater enjoyment, relaxation, and improved performance.

- Minimise multi-tasking and distractions: Instead of reacting to your phone whenever you hear it, choose to reply to messages and emails in these two zones:
 1) before the round, 2) after the first nine holes and before the 10th tee.
- 2. Let go of a poor shot or bad hole: In his prime, Vijay Singh had one of the most prominent post-shot routines to leave poor shots behind. Vijay would re-engage his practice swing and visualise the ball going exactly where he wanted it to go, moving to the next shot with a positive image in his mind. To enhance this practice further, place your club back into your bag only after you've wiped the poor shot from your mind.
- **3.** Don't play 'there-abouts' golf: Acknowledge that feeling of indecisiveness over the ball. This is an important habit in playing mindful golf. Walk away from the shot and start again if you are not fully committed and take multiple clubs to your ball if needed.
- 4. Bring more Zen into your pre-shot routine: The pre-shot routine isn't just about practice swings and club selection. The pre-shot routine is for letting go of tension in the body, enhancing commitment and clearing the mind right before you hit your shot. Think of **Jason Day**'s routine before he walks into the ball. He gently closes his eyes to visualise the shot and takes a slow deep breath, relaxing his mind and body. In his prime, **Tiger Woods** would talk about feeling so clear of thought but yet so focused on the target before playing a shot he felt his body was on auto-pilot and he couldn't hear a thing around him.

Probably my favorite example of Zen in a pre-shot routine (although in a different sport than golf), is owned by the Major League Baseball player **Ichiro Suzuki**. I had the pleasure of watching Ichiro at-bat for the Mariners in 2005.

For a sports psychologist like myself, who observes pre-shot routines all the time as part of my day job, there is nothing more memorable than Ichiro's routine. Like a Samurai, he created an effortless, rhythmic flow of movement with his bat and body. As he moved into position at the plate you could literally feel the poise, clarity and commitment he had at every hit. If you've never seen Ichiro's at-bat routine, check it out on YouTube because it is sure to give you some new inspiration for bringing more calmness and clarity into your pre-shot routine.

Experiment with finding a little more Zen in your pre-shot routine with a deep exhale before you address the ball, or try creating a rhythm and flow in your actions with only the target on your mind.
